

Drop off masks at BGH main registration door (front entrance between the 2 sliding doors). There is a clipboard to sign your name and a box to place masks inside.

How to make a face mask:

What you will need:

- Cotton fabric, two 9 inch x 6 inch pieces.
 - We prefer light-colored fabric if possible, to show soiling
 - We want two layers of tightly woven cotton (like quilters cotton), no flannel
 - Please prewash/preshrink fabric as it will be going through commercial wash/dry
- Rope elastic, beading cord elastic will work (you may also use 1/8" flat elastic)

Instructions:

1. Cut the elastic 7 inches long and tie a knot at each end. Do not knot the flat elastic.
*See below if you can't find elastic.
2. Put right sides of cotton fabric together,
3. Starting at the center of bottom edge sew to the first corner, stop. Sew the elastic with the knot out in the corner. A few stitches forward and back will hold this.
4. Sew to the next corner, stop, and bring the other end of that same elastic to the corner and sew a few stitches forward and back.
5. Now sew across the top of the mask to the next corner. Again, put an elastic with the knot out.
6. Sew to next corner and sew in the other end of the same elastic.
7. Sew across the bottom leaving about 1.5-2 inches open. Stop, cut the thread. Turn inside out.
8. Pin 3 tucks on each side of the mask. Make sure the tucks are the same direction.
9. Sew around the edge of the mask twice.

Be sure any fabric design is placed horizontally.
